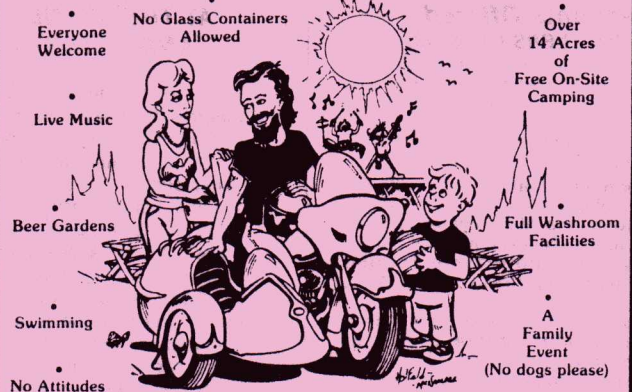

AT THE SCENE AND AFTER

You have to keep yourself together to make the best of a bad situation, so if you are in an accident and still conscious:

1. get out of the traffic,
2. get the names, addresses, driver's licence and licence plate number of anyone else involved, including witnesses. If you can't do it, ask somebody to help,
3. get medical help immediately and follow up on any problems,
4. file accident reports with the local police and the I.C.B.C. claim centre,
5. get legal advice. No matter how co-operative an I.C.B.C. representative may seem to be he works for an insurance company whose goal is to get the most in premiums and pay the least in claims.

A Brief Summary of our past Meetings

1987 calendar — Our first annual calendar is in the works. Calendar designer Sharon Hagel reported that the response from the motorcycle shops wishing to advertise in the calendar has been exceptional.

Helmet law report — On May 29, 1986 the validity of legislation concerning the helmet law was thrown out of court. However, tickets are still being issued. August 27 has been set for Supreme Court by the Attorney-General regarding an appeal. Any tickets received, it is suggested to have them put over till the end of summer and remember not to miss any dates on the tickets or a bench warrant will be issued.

Licensing — If you are riding with a Class 5 licence or a Leaner's Licence, you may not be liable to No Fault Insurance. I.C.B.C. seems to be tightening up and you may not get any financial assistance if involved in an accident without proper licencing.
